Measure your kitchen, bath, home office, family room, laundry room,

entertainment wall, den, workbench, wet bar, craft room...



How to measure your area:

- A** Measure the complete length of each wall starting in the left corner. Record your measurements in inches on the grid at the right.
- B** Show all the windows, closets, doorways, and fireplaces measuring from the left corner to the outside edges of the moulding.
- C** Measure from the left corner to the center line of all sinks, water drains, gas lines and electrical outlets.
- D** Mark the location of all permanent or remaining appliances and air vents.

Check to be sure the total measurements of B equal A.

Note the ceiling height and the refrigerator width and height.
